iCountability's ibAcus software to 'serve' back-end data collection professionals
Feature-rich array of new and powerful tools will add depth and increase user capabilities

Saint John, NB - Back-end data collection professionals are about to get a shot in the arm for their daily operations routine with the release of ibAcus software. Development firm iCountability Corp. has been focusing its expertise on producing a solution for inventory counting service companies which will benefit small and large operations alike. The product, which aims to meet the various demands of this exacting market has now been released. Trial version downloads and complete documentation were made accessible via the Company's website @ www.icountability.com commencing April 28, 2006, with a fully licensed version being made available for sale at the same time.

The ibAcus package, supported by its Cserver, iCounter, and iReporter components provides a unique and robust framework for performing site counting easily and securely. The framework design is the cornerstone of ibAcus, providing control and precision to the user at every level while embracing a multi-user counting model. All of this is accomplished through wireless connectivity utilizing hand held computers made by leading manufacturers.

ibAcus really shines when coupled with equipment using Windows CE 4.2/PPC2003. It supports various and multiple devices with a view to future integration and hardware compatibility, while permitting the simultaneous use of an amalgam of diverse hand held devices that run on the same OS.

The product is feature-rich, and its managed framework provides the user tools to enhance accountability, independent audit functionality, and data security in a client /server environment. The wireless ability provides live software updates that do not require cradling, as well as on-the-fly data synchronization resulting in prompt and reliable data delivery. The iReporter component builds convenient, well-formatted reports and can be freely distributed, thereby giving both inventory service firms and their customers the power to select, build, and print desired reports at any time, even while a count is active.

ibAcus supports in principle all CE-based devices from CE version 4.2 and up, and actively supports Pocket PC 2003 devices like the Symbol PDT 8146 and Intermec 700c series in scanning and financial modes. IPAQ PDAs combined with the Bluetooth-enabled Frogpad (for financial inventories) have also been supported as an example of the diverse technologies the software can embrace. The firm will consider support of Palm OS devices if demand warrants, as well as scanning devices developed for use in these and other PDAs. The server component is supported on Windows XP, and there is also an iCounter version built and supported for XP (a virtual hand held visible and usable on the server computer screen) .
